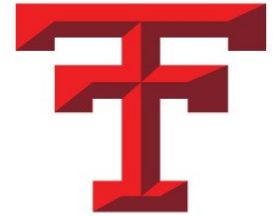

ACADEMICS:

One assessment tool that DCS uses to evaluate student progress is Measurement of Academic Progress (MAP) testing. The computer-based examinations are administered semi-annually to accomplish the following:

- Provide data teachers can use to personalize instruction
- Support efforts to engage students in their learning goals and progress
- To supply easy-to-understand information about every student's academic successes and opportunities
- To give students and their parents an opportunity to see how students perform in comparison with other students in the nation
- To measure each student's reading level (called his or her Lexile score)

Another assessment tool that DCS uses is the NDSA by Smarter Balanced aligned with common core. Being a private school, we can pick and choose the standards we feel are best for students. We also can go above and beyond those standards because of our high expectations that we hold for all students.
